

NWPA EXHIBITION 2010 - RULES

- 1} Entrants must be paid up members of a photographic club or society affiliated to the NWPA
- 2} Every constituent image forming part of an entry must be originated by photographic means by the author - **who must hold the original copyright of all such constituent parts.**
- 3} The exhibition is divided into 4 sections : Monochrome Prints - Colour Prints - Projected Images - Junior Images
- 4} FIAP/PAGB Definition of a MONOCHROME image - 'A B&W image is one which has only a single tone e.g. cool, warm, sepia etc. A B&W image which has been modified by the addition of another colour/partial tone is a colour image'
- 5} Submitted prints **must** be mounted on acceptable card **size 50x40 cm** {max thickness approximately 2.5mm} Any print smaller or larger will not be judged. Accepted prints will be framed by the NWPA.
- 6} Images for digital projection should be on a CD-R disc - **see separate details for submission requirements** . Discs will be destroyed after the exhibition. The Title of each digital image given on the entry form must correspond with that on the CD.
- 7} Images that are indistinguishable from each other or with the same title, whether prints or digital, will not be accepted for judging.
- 8} Each print must bear a title, the entrant's name and address and the name of their club/society. For CD's see separate details for requirements. **If this information is missing the entry will not be accepted.**
- 9} Accepted prints will be offered for sale {gallery requirement} and the amount expected by the author included on the entry form. The NWPA will add other costs - ie : gallery commission, cost of frame, VAT
- 10} The medium of entered prints must declared on the entry form {eg Silver Gelatin, Inkjet Dye, Inkjet Pigment, Bromoil, Lith, Cyanotype, Gold/Selenium toned etc.}
- 11} Images which have previously been accepted, or are indistinguishable from previously accepted images, cannot be entered in any category.
- 12} The right of the NWPA to reproduce accepted images for the catalogue, web-site, low resolution CD is given by the author at time of entry. Copyright remains with the author.
- 13} Junior entrants must be 18 years on or before the 1st of September 2010.
- 14} Submission of entry implies acceptance of the rules.
- 15} In the event of a dispute the decision of the Exhibition Secretary is final.

NOTES

- a) All entrants will be sent a catalogue
- b) Entrants wishing to know results before the Official Opening must enclose an SAE with the entry form
- c) Although every care will be taken with entries the NWPA and its Officers cannot accept liability for any loss or damage to entries
